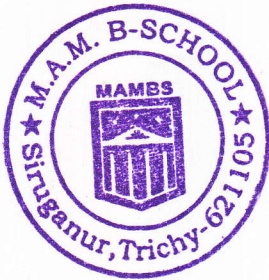

The Co-incubation network enables entrepreneurs to access all the expertise available to develop or improve new products/ services, bring them to market faster and cheaper in line with international standards.

Thus a Co-incubation network will help to ensure that in future the incubators will generate more successful companies. This will make the incubators act as the most effective tool for economic development of the country.

The Co-incubation will cover all of the facilities available in both the host Incubator and the co-incubators. Any incubatee enrolling for incubation programme in any of these incubators will have access to all the services in both incubators.

Proposed Incubation unit-- at M.A.M B-School as the Co-incubator will avail the expertise and services of Periyar TBI to support its on-boarding process of establishing the incubator services. Primary focus will be on the following support services

1. Creation of new cohorts for providing the incubation support at M.A.M B-School

During the said duration of the cohort, selected startup management teams can work with the pool of mentors and advisors of Periyar TBI so as to pitch their ideas to potential customers and investors. At the same time, incubator staff shall work with the companies to set up their operating processes. Each cohort usually ends with the Demo Day. During the Demo Day, companies from a cohort present the results of their work to an audience selected by M.A.M B-School and Periyar TBI.

2. Mentorship and advisory services

The mentorship and advisory services available with Periyar TBI shall be shared to the Proposed incubator at M.A.M B-School and their startups to reduce the gap in their knowledge or experience needed to make better decisions.

Mentoring support shall be provided to Co-incubated startups (need based engagement) along with Training & workshops. Periyar TBI shall guide them in seeking market access.

3. Access to industry experts and mentors

Periyar TBI shall provide access to industry experts and mentors, in addition to that, we have extended support to connect with the industrial stalwarts from their stakeholders at M.A.M B-School.

4. Capacity Building to the staff

Periyar TBI shall provide advice in startup intake, selection process and duration of the accelerator programme for each startup selected. The faculty of M.A.M B-School will be trained in all aspects of business incubation.

Periyar TBI shall also share space, specialized Infrastructure including Business Laboratories.

Periyar TBI will train the co-incubator staff about Incubation Funding and Seed support system available with various agencies. It also covers business development, legal services, IP and Strategy.

5. Other Services:

Periyar TBI shall participate in academic programmes (offering entrepreneurship courses), functions of E-Cells and events for promotion of entrepreneurship (Idea Generation and Business Plans, Hackathon Challenges etc.).

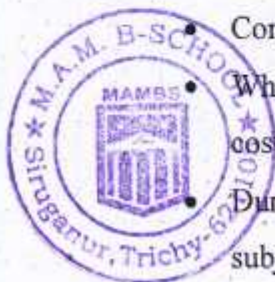
Mutually Agreed Consent:



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:
 - (i) **MASTeR GROUP OF INSTITUTIONS**
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education, Placement and Internship.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) – **Ageas Federal Life Insurance Co Ltd (Erode Branch)** – , the Second Party is engaged in Insurance , Skill Development, Education and Placement in the fields.
- F) – **Ageas Federal Life Insurance Co Ltd, Thirunagar Colony, Erode, Tamil Nadu 638003** – , the Second Party is promoted by **IDBI Federal Life**

Insurance Co Ltd.; 22 nd Floor, A Wing, Marathon Futurex, N. M. Joshi Marg, Lower Parel (East), Mumbai 400013, India. IRDAI Registration No. 135, 19 th Dec, 07.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTHIN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

**CLAUSE1
CO-OPERATION**

Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needsof the industry, the Second Party.

The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.



CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of insurance and Banking sector. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills, knowledge and Placement opportunity.

Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the scenario meaningfully.

Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the developments / requirements; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs (Internship) for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Internship / Workshops / Company Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

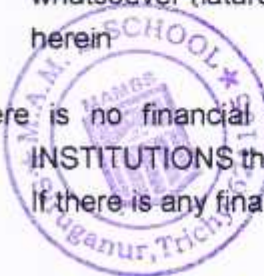
Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging needs in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements for at least 10% of the students. The Second Party will itself absorb at least 15 percentage of the trained students.

Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.

There is no financial commitment on the part of the MASTER GROUP OF INSTITUTIONS the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.



CLAUSE 3
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4
VALIDITY

This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **Ageas Federal Life Insurance Co Ltd (Erode Branch)**, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of **IDBI Federal Life Insurance Co Ltd**, 22 nd Floor, A Wing, Marathon Futurex, N. M. Joshi Marg, Lower Parel (East), Mumbai 400013, India. IRDAI Registration No. 135, 19 th Dec, 07., the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU

Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

CLAUSE 5
RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE
PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

WHEREAS:

1. **M.A.M.B-SCHOOL** is an educational institution that offers education in various fields of Arts, Science & Commerce and it is affiliated to Anna University
2. **GTT Foundation** is engaged in the field of education & employability domain that provides training to the students as part of their CSR activity
3. **M.A.M.B-SCHOOL** is willing to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with **GTTF** for the skills enhancement training program through the technology platform or other face to face initiatives.

NOW IT IS HEREBY/AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS UNDER:

1. Objective:

The objective of this MOU is to enable students of **M.A.M.B.S** access resources that would enhance their employability.

2. Period of MOU:

This MOU shall come into force and effect from the date of execution and shall remain valid for a period of **Two year** from such date after which the same may be reviewed by either party. However, if the same is not renewed this arrangement will be deemed terminated on the expiry of the said duration period.

3. Roles & Responsibilities of the M.A.M.B.S:

- a. M.A.M.B.S shall be responsible to nominate one person with adequate accountability and responsibility to coordinate the engagement. The person so appointed would act as the single point of contact (SPOC) for the proposed initiative.
- b. M.A.M.B.S shall share in their letterhead the details of the students who will attend the aforesaid training program with GTTF like name, email ID, contact details, Name of the Company in which Candidate is placed(current Company), qualification (along with the year of completion/pursuing) and other documents as per GTTF training requirements..
- c. It would be the responsibility of the M.A.M.B.S to ensure that proper publicity is made through M.A.M.B.S website.
- d. To encourage the Students to register for the Program by informing them about the benefits of the program
- e. M.A.M.B.S to refrain conducting any of their training or call with the students when GTTF training is going on.
- f. It would be their responsibility to ensure that all their students adhere to training schedule.
- g. To provide all the support services and facilities to GTTF during the conduct of the said Training Program.
- h. To coordinate with GTTF and facilitate conduct of all the assessments including the assessment to be conducted by the external agency (if any) identified by GTTF, as per schedule communicated by GTTF.
- i. To provide the placement details of the students who have undergone the aforesaid training.

4. Roles & Responsibilities of GTT:

- a. GTTF shall be responsible to provide access to employability enhancement related activities through blended learning model.
- b. GTTF will arrange for assessment of its own and also arrange external assessment as required.

5. Other Terms & Conditions:

Following are the other terms and conditions of MOU:

- a. The students enrolled should complete the training as scheduled.
- b. Program Coordinator to be appointed by M.A.M.B.S
- c. TPO's active support and participation is required for smooth & efficient conduct of the program.

- d. M.A.M.B.S shall not write/publish any material or use any logos/names of GTTF/ in any of the publications without prior written consent and approval from GTTF.

6. Commercial:

This skills enhancement **training program** is free of cost. GTT shall not charge any fees on whatsoever account/name from the students or M.A.M.B.S for conducting the aforesaid training program.

7. Certification:

Certificates shall be awarded by GTTF to the students on successful completion of the training and clearing of the assessment held post completion of the training program.

8. Limitations and Warranties :

Both parties agree that it would be their endeavor to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MOU terms by the other party.

9. Termination:

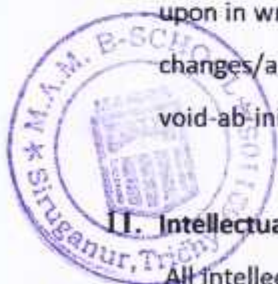
- a. Both parties can terminate the MOU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms of non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MOU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.
- b. Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavor that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programs, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

10. Entirety & Amendment:

This MOU contains the entire understanding between the Parties in relation to the Training Program. If during the operation of the MOU, circumstances may rise which call for alteration / modification to this MOU, such alteration / modification shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing. Such changes will be formalized in writing as an 'Addendum' to this MOU. Any changes/amendments to this MOU not in conformance to this section shall be deemed to be void-ab-initio.

11. Intellectual Proprietary Rights:

All intellectual or proprietary property and information, supplied or developed by either Party shall be and remain the sole and exclusive property of the Party who supplied or developed



same. Upon termination of this MOU and upon written request, the Party in receipt of the requesting Party's intellectual or proprietary property and/or information pursuant to this MOU shall return such information to the requesting Party.

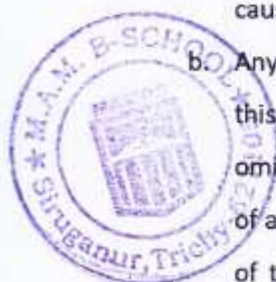
12. Confidential Information:

- a. Both parties undertake to each other to keep confidential all information (written or oral) concerning the business and affairs of the other, which has been obtained or received during the course(s) of performance hereunder, save that which is in consequential or obvious;
- b. Already in its possession other than as a result of a breach of this clause; or in the hands of the public other than as a result of a breach of this clause.
- c. In the event of any of the parties becoming legally compelled to disclose any confidential information, such party shall give sufficient notice to the other party so as to enable the other party to seek a timely protective order or any other appropriate relief. If such an order or other relief cannot be obtained, the party being required to make such a disclosure shall make the disclosure of the Confidential Information only to the extent that is legally required of it and no further.
- d. M.A.M.B.S agrees not to deal directly or enter into any business agreement with any of the partners or associates or customers of either party during the term of the agreement and also after the agreement have been terminated, not earlier than two years from the date of termination.

13. Force Majeure:

- a. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfill and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.

b. Any extraordinary event, which cannot be controlled by the parties, shall for the purpose of this MOU be considered as a Force Majeure event. Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its



obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.

14. Non-Solicitation:

M.A.M.B.S agrees that during the term of this Agreement and for a period of two (2) years after the termination or expiry thereof, it shall not, directly or indirectly, employ, contract, solicit, hire or otherwise utilize the services of an existing employee of GTTF
