




# Integral Development



# 800 students take pledge to save Cauvery

COINCIDING with Chief Minister MK Stalin's Manjal Pai campaign, over 800 students formed a human chain holding cloth bags in their hands on the Cauvery bridge early on Thursday, pledging to use the bags instead of plastics and protect the Cauvery.

The students took part in the event with Tiruchy International Airport Director S Dharmaraj, MAM-B School Director M Hemalatha, Thanneer Club president KC Neelamegam and secretary K Sathish Kumar, who had jointly organised it as part of the club's ongoing Save Cauvery initiative.

He also reminded the students how the whole delta area and Tiruchy, region are highly agricultural, and how the river is making this possible.




## MILLET FOOD CONTEST


#### Paper Presentation Competition: Environmental Protection & Growth and Development










M.A.M.B-School, a standalone Business School, Trichy in association with Women Empowerment Cell and POSH Cell organized guest lecture entitled "Work place Sexual Harassment" on 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2022. Mrs.R.Sridevi, Advocate, Radio Jockey in Suryan FM, Trichy was the resource person for the programme. The resource person initiated the session by giving information about POSH (Prevention of Sexual Harassment) under IPC Act 354 and 503. She said that in recent times the role of women at workplace has increased tremendously. However, they are vulnerable to harassment in the workplace. The Constitution of India plays a pioneer role in protecting the women from discrimination and ensuring gender justice in the present times. The guest speaker explained about Vishakha guidelines, what constitutes a sexual harassment, method of lodging complaint and the conduct of investigation. She pinpointed on the various circumstances leading to abuse, women's rights at the work place, the relevant laws and the officials they should report to in case of any adverse situation.
