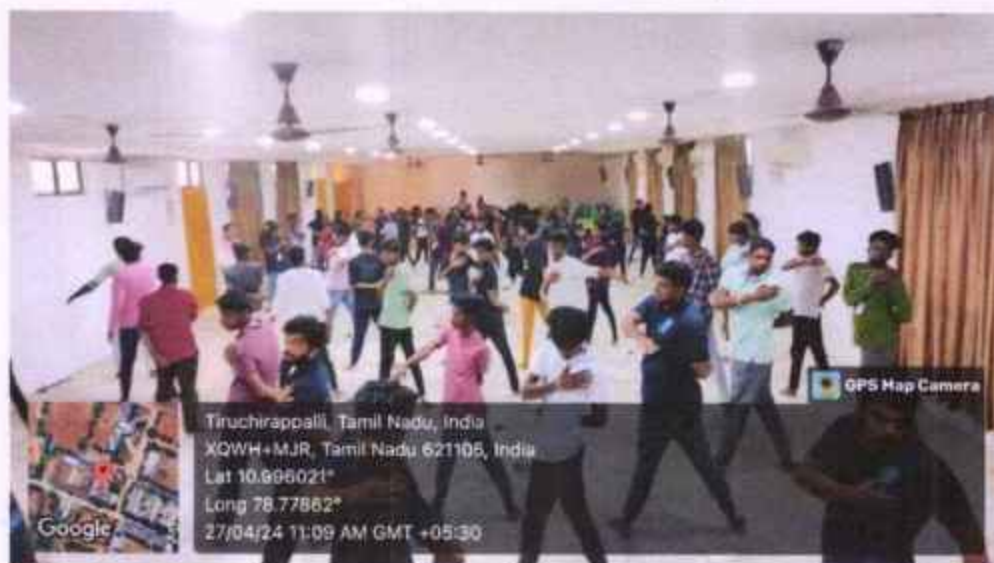


14. A SESSION ON "YOGA FOR HEALTH AND WELLNESS"

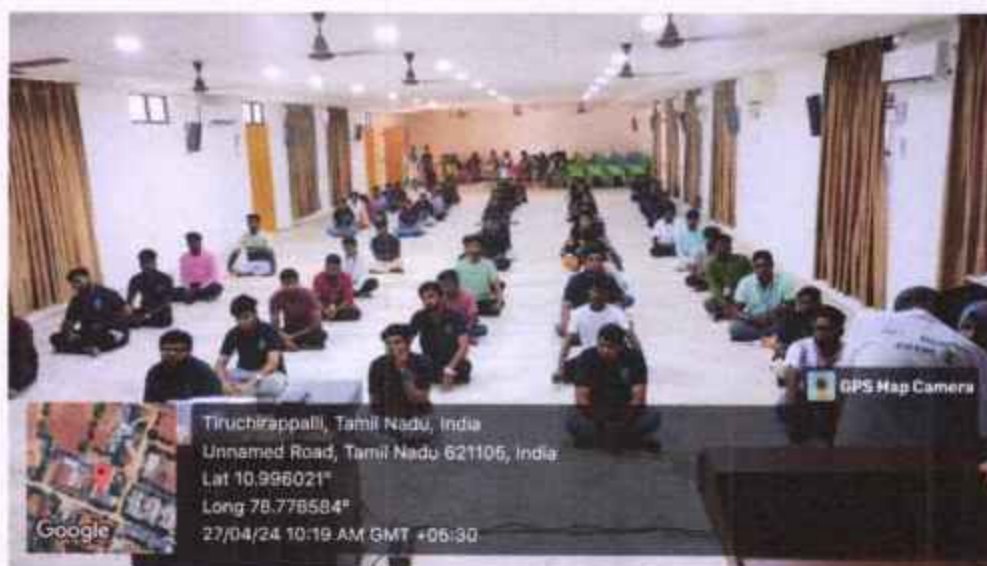

awareness and inspiring positive change in society, and they reflect the commitment of both the participants and the institution to these important issues.



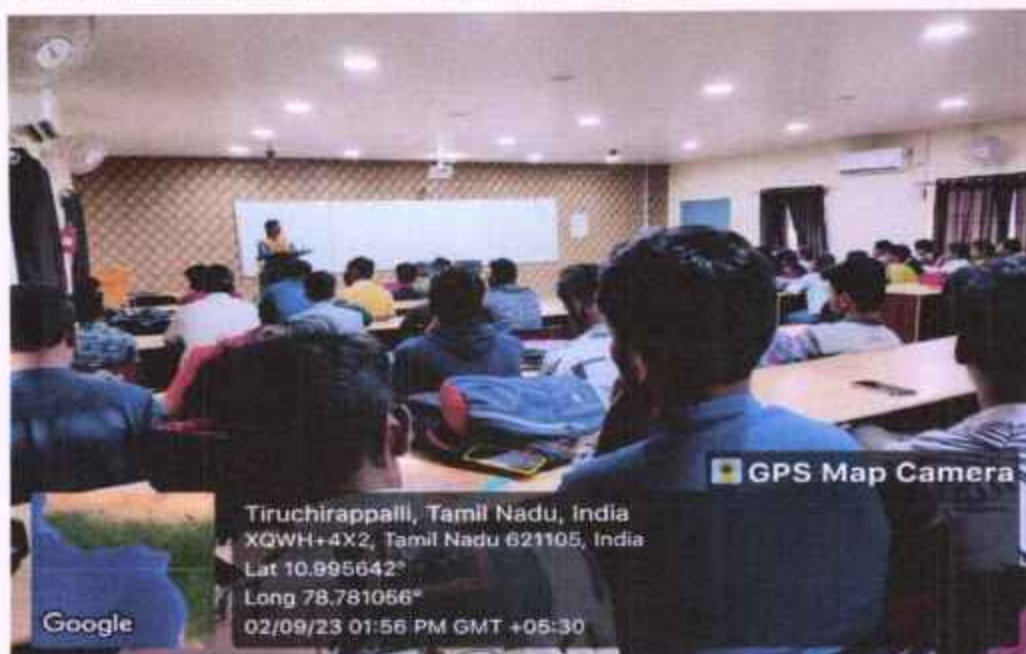

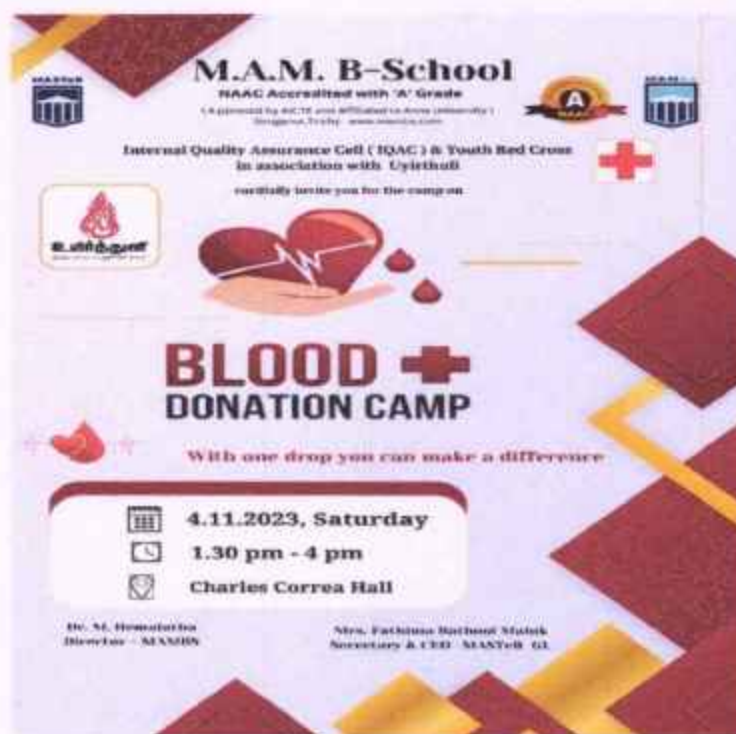

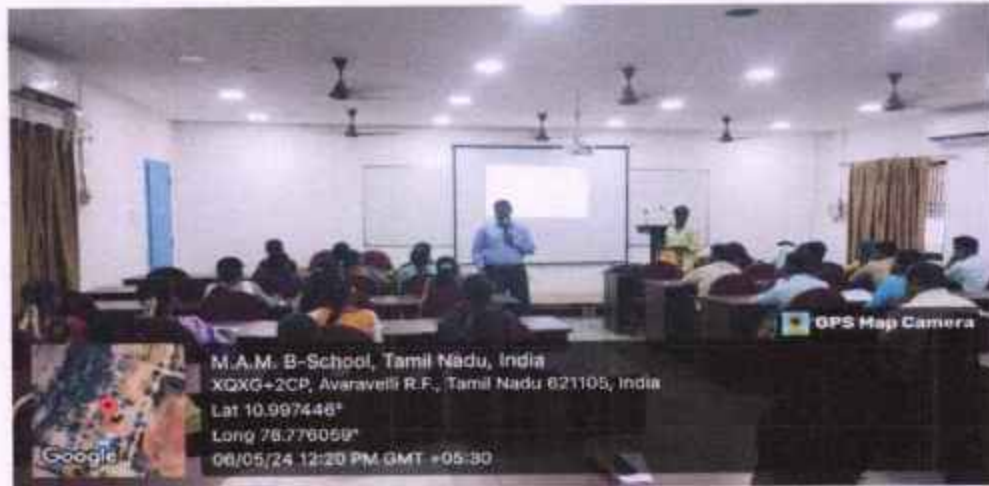
