





#### 2. WOMEN'S DAY PANEL DISCUSSION ON "ENTREPRENEURIAL JOURNEY"




The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from students who showcased a myriad of Posters to convey the importance of a Go green and pollution-free festival.











## 16. A SESSION ON "INDIAN LABOR LAWS FROM A PRACTICAL PERSPECTIVE"










#### 17. A SESSION ON "WOMENS RIGHTS"

awareness and inspiring positive change in society, and they reflect the commitment of both the participants and the institution to these important issues.




## 20. A SESSIONON "OPERATION MANAGEMENT IN SERVICE SECTOR"


