- An institution with a higher ratio of Female Students & Employees.



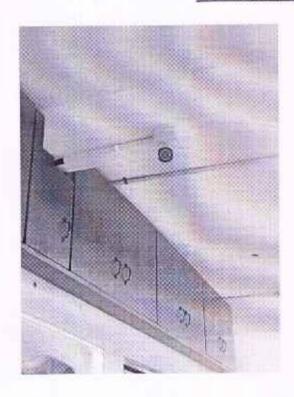

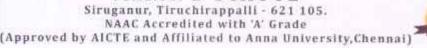


A session on "Evolving Face of Sexual Harassment in Changing Workplaces"
