District Environment Engineer (VRS), Tamilnadu Pollution Control Board

Dr. Rajasekhar's underscoring the interdependence between the environment and human well-being, he aimed to inspire students to recognize their responsibility towards preserving and protecting the environment. Dr. Rajasekhar's point about human activities posing threats to the environment in the name of development is an important one. Practices such as deforestation, industrial pollution, habitat destruction, and over-exploitation of natural resources can have severe consequences for ecosystems and biodiversity. Dr. Rajasekhar's emphasis on the importance of the environment in human life is fundamental. Highlighting this connection can help individuals understand the critical role that the environment plays in sustaining life on Earth and how our actions impact it. The loss of forests can disrupt natural cycles, lead to soil erosion, exacerbate climate change, and threaten the survival of countless plant and animal species he added. Trees play a vital role in mitigating climate change by absorbing carbon dioxide, stabilizing soil, and providing habitat for wildlife. He suggested to renewable energy sources like solar power, both on and off the grid, is a sustainable alternative to fossil fuels, reducing greenhouse gas emissions and dependence on finite resources.

The current average water usage of 135 litters per day is substantial, and reducing it can have significant benefits for both the environment and society. Encouraging individuals to adopt water-saving practices such as fixing leaks, using water-efficient appliances, and practicing mindful consumption can help conserve water and reduce strain on freshwater sources. He call to reduce carbon footprint aligns with global efforts to mitigate climate change and promote sustainability He enlighten that water auditing involves systematically evaluating water consumption patterns. Mr. S. Senthilkumar, Assistant Professor, Student's ExNoRa club coordinator M.A.M. B-School, made all the requisite arrangement for the programme.


Electoral Literacy Club Voter Pledge event


